Peter Ward: (B.Sc. ATPL AIPA) has been photographing the sky for over five decades and is one of Australia's most lauded astrophotographers. His images have won over 60 national and international awards. He was the Deep Sky photography winner for the coveted Royal Greenwich Observatory Astronomy photographer of the Year awards in 2020.

Peter was an Associate Editor at Southern Astronomy and Sky and Space magazines. His astrophotography has been published on the web, in local and national newspapers, numerous magazines, text books and have featured in a national advertising campaign and have been screened on national television . He was a vetting judge for the inaugural CWAS Malin awards in 2004 and was guest judge for the RASNZ Astrophotographic competition in 2016.

His portfolio is extremely diverse. He has won every photographic category of the CWAS David Malin awards showing mastery over an

impressive range of imaging techniques using varied cameras, lenses, telescopes, filters, focal lengths and software to create unique and compelling images of the heavens.
